#### Dress For Success

- Hair must be natural color
- No mohawks or distracting styles
- Jackets must be official Pinecrest jackets inside building
- No cat ears/tails, fidget spinners, or other distracting items
- Dry fit shirts are available and recommended
- Remote Live Instruction days do not require a uniform but do require appropriate clothing



### Uniforms

Shirts	<ul> <li>Navy (accepted at all Pinecrests)</li> <li>Pirate Blue</li> <li>Gray</li> <li>Black</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Must be purchased at the uniform store and monogrammed.</li> <li>May wear a solid navy, black, gray, or white long-sleeved shirt under a monogrammed polo shirt.</li> </ul>
Pants Shorts Skirts Jumpers	<ul> <li>Navy (accepted at all Pinecrests)</li> <li>Tan (accepted at all Pinecrests)</li> <li>Black</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Form fitting, cargo, joggers, denim material, denim style pockets, and all other variations are not acceptable for wear.</li> <li>Slacks are the only acceptable form of pants.</li> <li>Shorts and skirts must be no more than 3 inches above the knee and may not be cut-offs.</li> <li>Jumpers must be monogrammed and purchased from the vendor.</li> <li>*It is highly recommended that uniform pants be purchased through the uniform vendor, as these are the acceptable styles.</li> </ul>
Socks	<ul> <li>Solid Navy</li> <li>Solid White</li> <li>Solid Gray</li> <li>Solid Black</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Must be solid colors and matching.</li> <li>Cannot be worn covering the knee.</li> </ul>
Leggings Tights	<ul> <li>Solid Navy (accepted at all Pinecrests)</li> <li>Solid White</li> <li>Solid Gray</li> <li>Solid Black</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>May not be worn as pants.</li> <li>May be worn under skirts or jumpers</li> <li>Available for purchase at the vendor.</li> </ul>



#### Masks

- All staff, students in 4th grade and above, and all visitors on campus will be required to wear face masks on campus.
- Students will be permitted to remove face coverings while eating or drinking.
- Face masks must be solid color. Uniform colors are not required but solid color will be enforced. Bandanas, sleeves, and scarves will not be permitted.
- Students who do not comply with mask requirements or are using masks as a nuisance item will be subject to disciplinary action and may be sent home.
- Masks must be worn appropriately over the nose and mouth.
- If a student arrives at school without a mask or loses a mask during the school day, they will be provided a disposable mask from the front office and a \$1 fee will be applied through Infinite Campus.

#### Arrival Procedures

- Arrival begins at 8:00. Students arriving before 8:00 will be sent to TEAMS
- Carloop must enter through Dale Avenue
- Drop offs must be in car loop, no surrounding areas
- Parents must have masks if addressing staff
- Temperatures will be taken prior to students exiting the vehicle
- Pre-K will have a separate carloop
- Carloop closes at 8:25

### Dismissal Procedures

- Dismissal code will be provided
- Parents must enter through Dale Avenue
- Pre-K will have a separate carloop route
- May park in designated area and check students out on playground
- Walkers will be dismissed from campus alphabetically and exit grounds



### Dismissal Procedures

- Carloop tags
  - Distributed the week of August 10th
- Elementary will stay to the right lane, Secondary will stay to the left
  - Cars can not change lanes or they will be asked to circle back around
- Early dismissal first week- 3:00



### Car Loop Etiquette

- You must stay in your lane
- Driver should remain in car at all times
- Student must be able to open car door, and secure own car seat/seatbelt
- No smoking of any kind, including vaping
- No loud music/profanity
- No cell phone usage
- Car must be in park to allow student to enter/exit car
- Follow all staff directions, wait for staff to give an all clear before moving



## COVID19 Summary of Procedures

- During Phase 2, students may choose the full virtual model, A/B Cohort, or Half Day option (K, 1 only). Wednesday is reserved for campus cleaning.
- Students will be provided a schedule of times to log in for remote live instruction on their virtual days. Daily attendance is required.
- Assignments will be submitted through Google Classroom.



## COVID19 Summary of Procedures

- Classrooms will maintain social distancing guidelines.
- Students need to have personal supplies in backpack for on campus days.
- Lunches will be eaten in the classroom.
- TEAMS will be provided for students on their cohort day.
